Dear Parents / Carers

As students are already aware, I am organising for all the A-Level Art and Photography students in both years Twelve and Thirteen to visit London on Tuesday the 20<sup>th</sup> of September 2022. The visit will be an excellent opportunity for students to engage with artwork first hand and as such will support their growing knowledge and understanding of a range of different artistic approaches. We will travel by coach to London. Photography students will then be accompanied to Tate Modern, and Art students will be accompanied to Tate Britain.

Both Tate Modern and Tate Britain boast extensive permanent collections, displayed over a number of rooms. The size of both galleries can be daunting and it is difficult to view all the artwork in just one day, so all students are encouraged to investigate particular areas of interest online before the day of the visit.

In terms of practical arrangements for the day, all students will meet in the art department at Chenderit at 8.45am. Students will need to bring cameras or sketchpads and drawing materials with them. Food and drink are available to buy at the galleries, but this can be very expensive, so I would advise students to bring a packed lunch. Students will need to bring some money or a card in order to purchase tube travel on the day. Students might also wish to bring some extra money with them in case they wish to purchase books or postcards. Students will tell you that I am obsessed with art books, and there are certainly brilliant bookshops at both galleries. We will return to school at approximately 5.45pm, when students will need to be collected. I will ask students to contact you directly with a more accurate ETA when we are on the coach home.

We are asking for a contribution of £19 to cover the cost of this trip. As per our charging and remission policy. This trip/activity will only go ahead if we are able to cover the cost through voluntary contributions. Our preferred payment method is now online, via Parentpay. This can be accessed through the school website or directly at [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com). Please contact The Finance Office if you need a Parentpay password or assistance. All trip payment records, instalment payments, and running balances can now be tracked online. (Cash and cheques will also be accepted).

To secure the coach, I will need a firm commitment and complete payment from students by **September 14<sup>th</sup>**. I would hope that all students are able to attend this visit if possible.


