Dear parents and carers

As this year's examination series draws to a close, we would like to congratulate and thank each of our Year 11 and Year 13 students for their hard work since May. As this is the first set of summer exams that have been held since 2019, we fully appreciate the dedication that each of our students have put into their studies in order to prepare for these exams, and we hope that the resilience and excellent work ethic that they have shown will continue to benefit them in years to come. As the exams finish, thoughts inevitably turn to the GCSE and A Level results days, which are being held on 18<sup>th</sup> August and 25<sup>th</sup> August respectively this year. Please read through the following information which outlines the arrangements for each of these days.

### A Level Results Day

The A Level results day takes place on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> August** and your child will be able to collect their results from the school's Sports Hall between **9:00am and 12:00pm** on this day. If your child has applied to university, they will be informed by email and through their UCAS Track account if they have met the entry requirements to enrol onto their chosen course at approximately 8:00am (this can be later though due to the volume of information being released by UCAS, but typically all places are confirmed via Track by 8:30am). If your child's results mean that they have not met the conditions of either of their university offers, or they change their mind and wish to apply to university after reflecting on their results, they will be eligible to apply for clearing through UCAS. It is important that students do not make any quick decisions here without discussing them with yourselves as parents and carers, and us as their teachers. There is plenty of time for students to make a considered decision so please do remind your child of this. Updates on vacancies will appear on [www.ucas.com](http://www.ucas.com) and students can apply for any course that has places left, and in some cases the universities will contact them directly. We will be available at school from 9:00am to 12:00pm to give assistance and support for those students who may require this service.

For those students who have applied for apprenticeships or employment, or are still in the process of doing this, we are more than willing to provide a reference for them. It would be helpful if your child could inform us of when and where they are applying beforehand if they have decided to change to this pathway so we can let them know if we do not receive correspondence from their employer.

Once they have collected their results from the Sports Hall, all students must ensure that they complete their details on the destinations forms which will be given to them. This is a compulsory requirement as the information is requested by the local authority so please do take the time to check that your child has completed the form to tell us where they are going to be studying or working from September 2022 onwards. **All students need to confirm destinations with the school by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022.**

### **GCSE Results Day**

GCSE results are being released on **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August** and your child will be able to collect their results from the Sports Hall between **9:00am and 12:00pm**.

If your child has applied to join the Sixth Form, or has not yet applied but wishes to do so, they will then be able to meet with a member of the Sixth Form Team in the lecture theatre once they have collected their results. Their results will be reviewed to check that the entry requirements for their courses have been met, and they will then be enrolled into the Sixth Form.

Once your child has collected their GCSE results from the Sports Hall, they will also need to complete their details on the destinations forms which will be given to them. This is a compulsory requirement as the information is requested by the local authority so please do take the time to check that your child has completed the form to tell us where they are going to be studying or working from September 2022 onwards.

If your child has ordered a leavers' yearbook and/or hoodie, they will also be able to collect these from the Sports Hall on GCSE results day.

If your child is unable to attend their results day, please contact Mrs Files ([sfiles@chenderit.net](mailto:sfiles@chenderit.net)) to arrange an alternative time for them to collect their results or have them emailed to them. As we also require destinations information to be collected, please also ensure that you or your child email Mr Belstone ([bbelstone@chenderit.net](mailto:bbelstone@chenderit.net)) so we are aware of their post-16 or post-18 destination for September 2021. **All students need to confirm destinations with the school by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022.**

Certificates for the summer exams will be available from the Examinations Office from mid November 2022. Any person nominated by students to collect these certificates on their behalf must contact Mrs Files in advance to approve this.

On behalf of each member of staff at Chenderit, we look forward to celebrating your child's achievements on each results day this summer, and in the meantime, we wish you an enjoyable summer break.
