The Religious Studies Department are delighted to offer an opportunity to visit key Religious sites and exhibitions in London on Extended Project Day which will be held on Tuesday 20th September 2022. We are hoping that this day will serve as an opportunity to extend students' wider knowledge of Religious themes to support their learning in class.

During the day, we will be visiting three key attractions in London. We will start the day by visiting the Auto-icon of Jeremy Bentham (<http://www.ucl.ac.uk/bentham-project/who/autoicon>). Students have studied Bentham's key teachings as part of their ethics course and have shown an interest in finding out more. From here, we will move on to the British Museum to explore exhibitions based on different religions and culture. We hope that visiting this exhibition will allow students to deepen their knowledge of early religious belief. (<https://www.britishmuseum.org/>). Westminster Abbey will be our final attraction of the day. We would like students to have the opportunity to visit a beautiful religious building and to deepen their background knowledge of Christianity (<https://www.westminster-abbey.org/>)

Students will be travelling to London by coach leaving from school at 9am and returning by 5.30pm. Students will need to bring lunch with them – cafes will be available but not guaranteed due to time restrictions throughout the day.

The cost of this trip will be £26 per student. This includes entrance to the attractions stated above. Students will need to bring either an Oyster card with them or can purchase an Underground travel ticket on the day. Please return the slip and payment by Monday 12th September.
