Dear parents and carers,

Year 7 History Visit – Warwick Castle Tuesday 25 September 2018

The History Department has arranged a day visit to Warwick Castle on Tuesday 25th September which is Extended Project Day 1.

In the Year 7 history course students spend the autumn term investigating Medieval England, including the development of castles. The trip to Warwick provides a wonderful opportunity for students to learn at first-hand about why castles were built, the changing uses of castles over time and about the lives of those who lived and worked in castles. A trail has been devised to cover these areas of study. Students will have a booklet to complete as they go round the castle, and will need to bring a pen for this purpose.

We are asking for a contribution of £12.00 to cover the cost of this trip. As per our charging and remission policy, this trip/activity will only go ahead if we are able to cover the cost through voluntary contributions. This includes entry to the castle and the cost of travel by coach. Our preferred payment method is now online, via Parentpay. This can be accessed through the school website or directly at www.parentpay.com. Please contact The Finance Office if you need a Parentpay password or assistance. All trip payment records, instalment payments, and running balances can now be tracked online. (Cash and cheques will also be accepted).

Students should bring a packed lunch and need to wear school uniform. A suitable outdoor coat is required as we are outside all day, regardless of the weather. Students could bring a small amount of spending money to spend at the gift shop if there is time during the day.

For students to be able to participate in educational visits, school organised events or school related activities good student behaviour is of paramount importance. If a student presents regular poor behaviours in school and/or we consider that the student presents a significant, unmanageable or unacceptable risk to the health, safety and/or welfare of that student or others on the trip, including the adult leaders, the student is unlikely to be able to participate.

The coach will leave school at 9.00am. **We will return to Chenderit in time for the school buses at 3.05pm.**
