

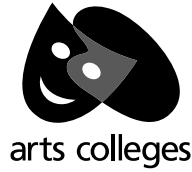

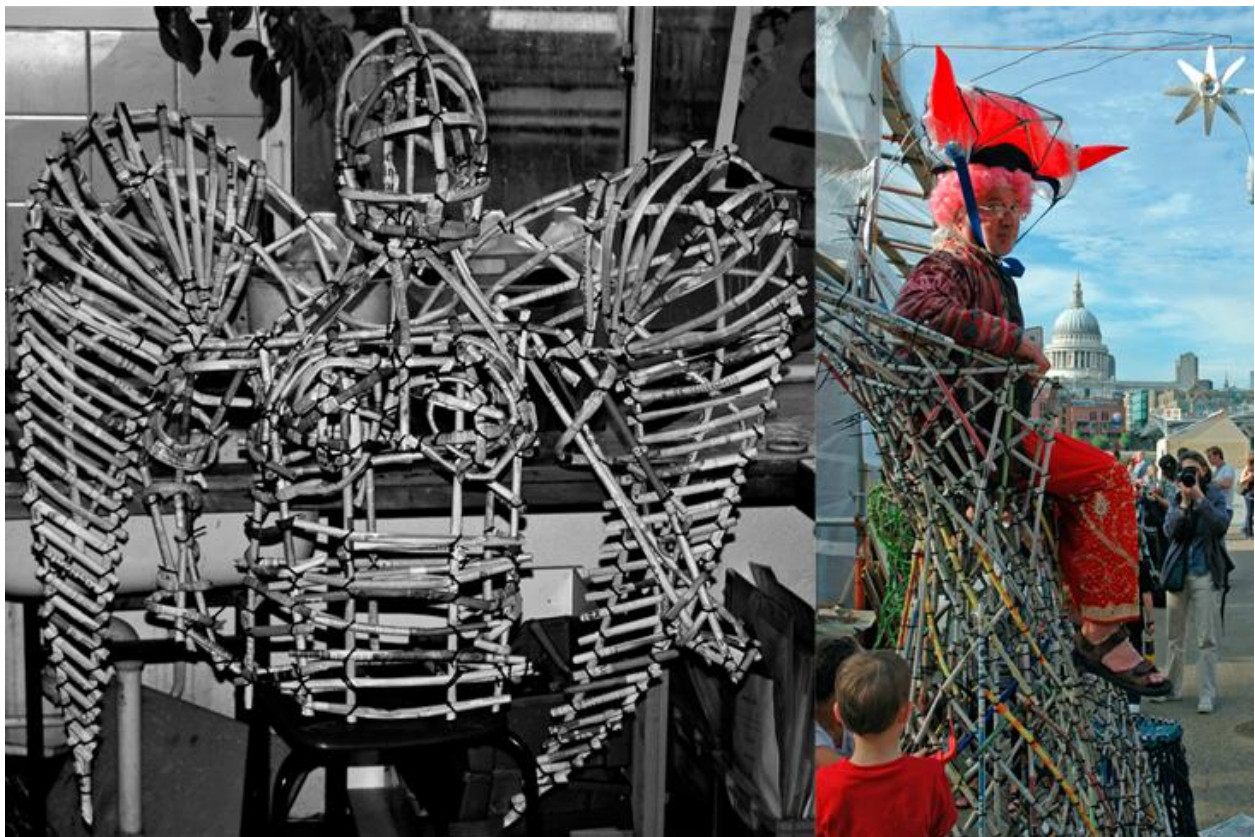


Dear Parent/Carer,

On Thursday 6th October we will be hosting a unique 3D Sculpture workshop for drama and design students/ Students will meet Darcy Turner and he will explain his 'Newspaper Stixx' method of creating large set pieces.

The 'Newspaper Stixx' method utilises a specially designed machine which enables newspaper to become as hard as wood. Darcy then creates large 3D sculptures from the material. Below are some sculptures made using the technology.

This unique workshop would particularly appeal to students interested in Theatre Design as a future career. Students could pursue a careers in the arts focusing on acting, design or directing. We want to explore how a career within design could include: set design, lighting, costume and make up.

Students will have the opportunity to work in teams where they will develop new skills and collaborate to create large scale sculptures and set pieces that will benefit and enhance performance work. One year 11 GCSE drama group are staging their own interpretation of 'Wind in the Willows' for their final performance examination and are keen to create a boat for Rat and Moley to use within the performance.
