Dear parents and carers

Re: On-site lateral flow testing for all students on their return to school in January 2022

I urge you to read this letter carefully to identify the precise arrangements regarding your child's return to school in January.

In order to facilitate a lateral flow test for each student, we have arranged for a staggered return to school in January. Students in Y10, Y11, Y12, and Y13 will return to school on Wednesday 5th January 2022, and students in Y7, Y8 and Y9 will return on Thursday 6th January 2022. For logistical reasons, these are the only two days that we are offering on-site lateral flow testing.

For our testing programme to be able to work efficiently, not all students will be able to arrive in school at the same time, therefore particular attention needs to be paid to the arrangements below:

On Thursday 6th January, all students in years 10-13 who had negative LFT result on Wednesday 5th January should come to school as usual, and for those who typically catch a school bus this means being at the bus stop at the usual time.

For students in years 7-9, the dedicated school transport service will be running an **additional bus service** to each village, and these student must catch the bus at the times specified below.

Please note that students in years 7-9 must not attempt to get on the earlier dedicated school transport service bus and students in years 10-13 must not attempt to get on the later dedicated school transport service bus. In such cases entry will be refused.

The testing will be held in the sports hall. Students will need to arrive at the external entrance near the maths block, and await their turn to be registered and then tested. All students must wear a face covering (unless formally exempt) throughout.

Students will undertake a supervised lateral flow test, await their result and when this has been confirmed as negative, they will follow their usual timetable. Those who test positive will be isolated from others and a parent or carer will be contacted to collect them from school immediately. In this circumstance, you will be asked to follow the appropriate government guidance and obtain a confirmatory PCR test as soon as possible.

In order to keep our school as safe as possible and to do our very best to avoid disruption in the spring term, I am asking you to embrace a '*belt-and-braces*' approach – as well as ensuring your child undertakes our on-site, supervised LFT, as required by the government, please also consider ensuring your child takes a home LFT at the end of the Christmas holiday and prior to boarding any transport or mixing with other students.

Further consent for this round of testing is not required, however if your child was not tested previously in school or you had not provided consent and you now wish for your child to have a supervised LFT please send this in writing to rbrenchley@chenderit.net no later than Friday 17th December.

If students are not in school for all, or any part of Wednesday 5th and Thursday 6th January, they will be expected to access online learning which their teacher will present live from school. We shall register students as usual for each of their lessons and any morning or afternoon absence from online learning will be recorded as absent from school. If, on either of these days, your child is unwell and therefore absent from school, please ensure you call or email our attendance officer as usual, to inform us of your child's absence. 
Our usual school facilities such as the canteen and other welfare services will be available to students from 8:00am on Wednesday 5th January.
