Dear Parents/Carers

I am organising a visit for KS4 Modern Languages (French) students to watch a short theatrical performance **in French** at **Tudor Hall School, Bloxham on Tuesday 29th November 2022**. This visit will allow students to practise their listening skills and also to experience languages in use beyond the classroom. It will also develop their understanding of the language in a new context. This visit will take place during the school day and students would be back in time for the end of period 3/ beginning of period 4.

The performance will last approximately 1 hour and it is organised by Onatti Productions Ltd and more information can be found at www.onatti.co.uk/copy-of-onatti-plays. The title of the performance is 'La Maison Hantée'(The Haunted House). We will aim to familiarise students with the script and context of the play in their lessons before the visit so that they can enjoy it as much as possible.

Please note that there will be a similar visit for students studying GCSE German in March 2023.

Timetable for the day:

09:10 - Depart from Chenderit School and travel by coach (Cheney Travel) to Tudor Hall School, Bloxham

09:40 - Arrive at Tudor Hall School and go to the assembly hall to watch the performance

9:50-10:50 (approx.) - Watch the performance (students from Tudor Hall and other schools will be present)

10:50 – Refreshments (juice and biscuits) after the performance before the return journey to Chenderit School

11:30 – Return journey to Chenderit School (Cheney Travel). Students to go straight to the remainder of period 3 on arrival.

The rest of the school day at Chenderit continues as normal.

Important information:

Students must wear full school uniform and bring the books they will need for the rest of the school day. The school's behaviour policy applies to this visit and this includes the use of mobile phones or other electronic devices, including cameras. All such devices will be confiscated (if seen or used) in line with school policy. Students will not need to bring any money with them because the refreshments (juice and a biscuit) will be offered, free of charge. If a student requires any medication then please make sure they have this with them or contact me to discuss their medical needs, if required.

Students will need to speak to their teachers for the subjects that they will miss due to this visit and they will be expected to catch up on any work that they will miss.

Please note that the number of places for this visit is limited to 65 and places will be issued on a first come, first served basis (payment and permission slip received). Students who apply after we have reached 65 will be placed on a waiting list, in case a place becomes available.

Behavioural expectations for the visit:


