Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you to those of you who were able to attend the virtual parent presentation delivered by The Bushcraft Company on Thursday 11th November. We hope you found this presentation interesting and it has excited your child about Year 7 Camp next year!

As you are already aware, Year 7 camp will run from Monday 20th June until Friday 24th June 2022 with The Bushcraft Company at Boughton Woods in Kettering. We will travel to and from the campsite during the hours of the school day. Camp is a fantastic opportunity for students to challenge themselves away from home and develop fantastic key skills.

The cost of each child place will be £320. This covers all transport, accommodation, food and activities. Please pay the deposit of £80 by 10th December 2021. We understand this is short notice but due to COVID there have been delays organising this event and making this fantastic opportunity possible. Our preferred payment method is now online, via ParentPay. This can be accessed through the school website or directly at www.parentpay.com. Please contact the Finance Office if you need a ParentPay password or assistance. All trip payment records, instalment payments, and running balances can now be tracked online. (Cash and cheques will also be accepted). A following payment of £80 will be expected around February-March 2022 and the outstanding balance will be expected in April 2022. However, you will be able to make payments as often as you would like in order to meet the scheduled payments.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals (FSM) please contact me at lcramb@chenderit.net and I will be able to discuss the options available to you.

In the New Year, once we have received your deposit, a data collection form will be sent to you with the necessary medical/dietary information that we require. We will also send out further information including kit lists, etc. nearer the time.

Also attached to this letter is a copy of the questions that parents asked during the live presentation from The Bushcraft Company as well as a copy of their brochure. This is a sample of the daily activities they offer. We have not finalised the complete itinerary and as such cannot confirm that each day will be as stated in this brochure. Within this brochure, you will also find a copy of the kit list The Bushcraft Company require your child to bring with them.

Please be aware that the entire educational visit may have to be re-scheduled due to Covid-19. If cancelled or curtailed due to Covid-19 our cancellation cover will support refunds.

In the event that your child is unable to participate due to covid-19, our cancellation cover and refunds require evidence of a positive PCR test or evidence of trying to obtain the PCR test results (e.g. dated/timed telephone calls and/or emails).

Refunds WILL be available if on departure:

- Your child has a positive PCR
- Your child is required to isolate by NHS Test and Trace
- Your child has Covid-19 symptoms and awaiting a PCR test result

Refunds are NOT available if on departure:

- Your child is under the age of 18 years and 6 months and has been identified as a close contact
- Your child is fully vaccinated and has been identified as a close contact

Of course, for students to be able to participate in educational visits, school organised events or school related activities good student behaviour is of paramount importance. If a student regularly behaves poorly and/or we consider that the student presents a significant, unmanageable or unacceptable risk to the health, safety and/or welfare of that student or others on the visit, including the adult leaders, the student is unlikely to be able to participate.

I do hope your child will join us for this fantastic and rewarding opportunity.
