

Catch-Up Pupil Plan 2014-15

We are required to publish information about the Year 7 literacy and numeracy catch-up programme. For 2014-15 the school received £9,000. This is £500 for each student in year 7 who did not achieve Level 4 in either English (reading) or Maths.

This funding has helped to provide the following support for our targeted students:

- Contribution towards summer school funding which provides focussed catch-up activities in literacy and numeracy and an accelerated induction into learning at Chenderit School
- Contribution towards the costs of the Read, Write Inc programme developing literacy skills
- Contribution towards the costs of additional small group teaching focussing on literacy and numeracy skills
- Contribution towards Sam Learning and My Maths online resources for students
- Contribution towards the appointment of a primary school trained Maths specialist to support rapid progression from Level 3 Maths
- Contribution towards additional support and training for teaching staff in developing differentiation
