<b>Week Beginning 21/09/2020</b>	Year 11 Assembly and tutor time activities	Mr Belstone's assembly and the follow up tutor activities focus on what life is like in Chenderit Sixth Form and what other progression routes are available to students post 16, including college and apprenticeships.
<b>09/10/2020</b>	Return of Initial Interest Form	This form allows students to voice their interest in course choices for 2021-2023 and we will use this information to try to reduce popular subjects clashing with one another.
<b>26/11/2020</b>	Sixth Form Virtual Open Evening	An opportunity for all prospective students to find out about the sixth form, to 'meet' subject staff virtually and to start the process of choosing courses for next year. Application forms and prospectus pages will be available for prospective students to download and view from this date.
<b>December 2020- February 2021</b>	Online tours and virtual meetings	During this time, we would normally invite external students wishing to join Chenderit to tour the school before submitting an application form, but due to the restrictions as a result of the pandemic this is not possible. Instead, we are able to offer virtual meetings with students and their parents and carers, alongside publishing a range of resources, such as a virtual tour of the Sixth Form, on our website.
<b>08/01/2021</b>	Deadline for internal applications and subject choices to the sixth form to ensure February interview	Students submitting applications on and prior to this date will be interviewed at the end of January and into February.  Applications received after this date will still be accepted but interviews will take place at a later date.
<b>25/01/2021</b>	Year 11 into 12 interviews for Chenderit students begin	Students are invited to discuss course and options with the sixth form team once the application forms have been received. This process will last over several weeks.
<b>05/02/2021</b>	Deadline for external applications and subject choice to the Sixth Form	Students submitting applications on and prior to this date will be interviewed at the end of February and into March.  Applications received after this date will still be accepted but interviews will occur at a later date.
<b>22/02/2021</b>	Year 11 into 12 interviews for external applicants begin	Students are invited to discuss course and options with the sixth form team once the application forms have been received. Depending on safety regulations at the time, these interviews may take place virtually rather than in person.
<b>May, June and July 2021</b>	GCSE Examinations – the government have confirmed that most examinations will start after June 7 <sup>th</sup> 2021 and are expected to run until July 2 <sup>nd</sup> 2021. A limited number will still take place prior to the May half term.	
<b>22/06/2021</b>	Sixth Form Induction Day	Students can attend taster sessions and get to know the school, staff and students. Depending on safety regulations at the time, this may take place virtually rather than in person.
<b>27/08/2021</b>	GCSE results received – exact timings will be published nearer to the time	Mr Belstone, Mrs Rowe and other senior staff are available at school on results day to offer advice and support. All students joining the sixth form must see Mr Belstone or Mrs Rowe to confirm their places.
