<b>Week Beginning 27/09/2021</b>	Year 11 Assembly	Mr Belstone's assembly and the follow up tutor activities focus on what life is like in Chenderit Sixth Form and what other progression routes are available to students post 16, including college and apprenticeships.
<b>01/11/2021</b>	Return of Initial Interest Form	This form allows students to voice their interest in course choices for 2022-2024 and we will use this information to try to reduce popular subjects clashing with one another.
<b>25/11/2021</b>	Sixth Form Open Evening	An opportunity for all prospective students to find out about the sixth form, to meet subject staff and to start the process of choosing courses for next year. Prospectus pages will be available for prospective students to collect and download from this date and our online application form will also go live.
<b>December 2021- February 2022</b>	Visits to the school and Sixth Form facilities	During this time, we invite external students wishing to join Chenderit to tour the school before submitting an application.
<b>07/01/2022</b>	Deadline for internal applications and subject choices to the sixth form to ensure February interview	Students submitting applications on and prior to this date will be interviewed at the end of January and into February.  Applications received after this date will still be accepted but interviews will take place at a later date.
<b>24/01/2022</b>	Year 11 into 12 interviews for Chenderit students begin	Students are invited to discuss courses and options with the sixth form team once applications have been completed online and received. This process will last over several weeks.
<b>04/02/2022</b>	Deadline for external applications and subject choices to the Sixth Form	Students submitting applications on and prior to this date will be interviewed at the end of February and into March, after the half term break.  Applications received after this date will still be accepted but interviews will occur at a later date.
<b>21/02/2022</b>	Year 11 into 12 interviews for external applicants begin	Students are invited to discuss courses and options with the sixth form team once applications have been completed online and received. This process will last over several weeks.
<b>May, June and July 2022</b>	GCSE Examinations – most examinations usually start at the beginning of June after the half term break and usually run until late June/early July. A limited number will still take place prior to the May half term. Please bear in mind that these dates have not been confirmed by the government or Ofqual and arrangements for the 2022 exam series are still being consulted on.	
<b>21/06/2022</b>	Sixth Form Transition Day	Students can attend taster sessions and get to know the school, staff and students.
<b>25/08/2022</b>	GCSE results received – exact timings will be confirmed and published nearer the time	Mr Belstone, Mrs Rowe and other senior staff are available at school on results day to offer advice and support. All students joining the sixth form must see Mr Belstone or Mrs Rowe to confirm their places.
