Sixth Form Subject Entry Requirements

All students who wish to study at Chenderit Sixth Form require **5 GCSEs grade 9-4, including English and Mathematics**. If students obtain 5 GCSEs graded 9-4, but do not gain a 4 in English or Mathematics, then they are still able to enrol and study with us, but will be required to continue to work to gain a grade 4 in the required subject by attending resit classes.

Certain subjects may also require specific grades, or in the case of subjects that have not previously been studied, a grade in a related discipline. These requirements are outlined below:

Subject	Entry Requirements
Art and Design – Fine Art	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics, and Art at grade 4+.
Art and Design - Photography	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics, and Art at grade 4+ or a strong interest in Photography.
Biology	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics, and grade 5+ in Combined Science or in Biology plus one other Science.
Business Studies	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics. Business Studies at grade 4 is preferred.
Chemistry	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English (grade 4+) and Mathematics (grade 5+). Grade 5 in Combined Science or in Chemistry plus one other Science.
Drama and Theatre Studies	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4 including English and Mathematics. Drama at grade 4 is preferred.
English Language and Literature	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
English Literature	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
Food Science and Nutrition**	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics. Food Preparation and Nutrition at grade 4+ is preferred.
Geography	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
Government and Politics	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
Health and Social Care*	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
History	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
Mathematics	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English (grade 4+) and Mathematics (grade 6+).
Further Mathematics	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English (grade 4+) and Mathematics (grade 6+).

***Level 3 Cambridge Technical Qualification.** Health and Social Care can be studied as a certificate (the equivalent of 1 A Level) or a diploma (the equivalent of 2 A Levels).

****Level 3 Applied Diploma.**

The Cambridge Technicals and Applied Diplomas are vocational qualifications that hold the same weighting as A Levels.

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Media Studies	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
Modern Foreign Languages	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics. The chosen language at grade 5+ through the higher tier paper is preferred.
Music	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics. Grade 5 in GCSE Music (with at least 50% in the listening paper) or music grade 4 on an instrument is essential.
Physical Education	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
Physics	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English (grade 4+) and Mathematics (grade 6+). Grade 5 in Combined Science or in Physics plus one other Science.
Product Design	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics. Design and Technology at grade 4+ is preferred.
Psychology	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
Religious Studies	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.
Sociology	5 GCSEs graded 9 – 4, including English and Mathematics.

In exceptional circumstances, for example students who have completed different qualifications with the same academic weighting other than those mentioned above, students should speak to Mr Belstone and enrolment onto courses will be determined at the Sixth Form Team's discretion.
