What will you study?

You will complete past papers looking at how to infer, deduce, comprehend, summarise and paraphrase. The writing papers will help develop your understanding of how writers use purpose, audience and form and you will have the opportunity to develop skills writing for different audiences and different forms.

Why study this subject?

Do you need a further opportunity to secure that all important grade 4, 5 or better in English Language? This course looks at developing your reading, writing and speaking and listening skills.

How will you be assessed?

Two exams, both lasting two hours, focus on reading and writing. Each paper is 50%. A speaking and listening presentation must be completed but is graded separately and does not count towards the GCSE grade.
